From the South: I-71 North to exit 165 Lexington/Bellville. Right on OH-97. Right on Main St/OH-13. Second left on Durbin Rd at traffic light. The camp entrance is in 1.5 miles on the right.

From the North: I-71 South to exit 169 Bellville/Mansfield. Left on OH-13 into Bellville. Approximately 6.5 miles, at the third traffic light, turn left on Durbin Rd. The camp entrance is in 1.5 miles on the right.
