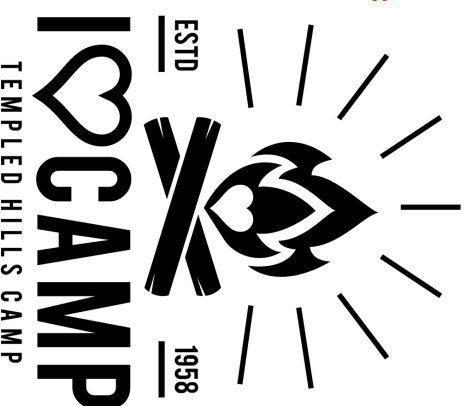

WHY CAMP?

Heartland Conference Summer Camp provides lasting long-term increased outcomes in:

- faith formation and faith relevance
- empathy and compassion
- appreciation for diversity
- self confidence
- family devotional practices
- congregational engagement

Those who attend camp as youth are significantly more likely to participate in community religious practices as young adults, including church attendance. Also, they are more likely to remain religious five years later than those who did not attend camp.

WHAT IS CAMP?

Heartland Conference UCC Summer Camp at Templed Hills is five valuable, vital things:

- faith centered
- safe space
- participatory
- unplugged from home
- relational

Of the 2019 campers surveyed, 95% said they wanted to come back to camp and 97% said they learned more about God at camp.
